Your will only governs the disposition of probate assets. Nonprobate assets pass according to beneficiary or survivor designations at the first spouse's death (after that, they may become probate assets to pass according to the second spouse's will). Keeping the disposition of your nonprobate assets consistent with your estate plan is your responsibility!
